Prayer Diary

Over the coming week, let us focus our prayers to our brothers and sisters in Christ, who are persecuted for their faith.

Monday 16th March – North Korea

North Korea is the most dangerous place in the world to be a Christian. Pray for the thousands of Christians, who are incarcerated in prison camps, and the many secret believers, who face arrest, disappearance, torture or public execution if discovered.

Tuesday 17th March - Somalia

In Somalia, if you are suspected of being a Christian, you will be killed instantly. Despite this evangelism is still able to take place through the use of the radio. Ask for protection for the secret believers as they risk their lives in order to reach out to other isolated Christians.

Wednesday 18th March – Iraq

Most Christians in Iraq have fled due to the horrific conditions in the Islamic Controlled State (IS). Pray for healing and provision for the thousands of refugees who had to leave everything behind. Praise God that He is using His church in Kurdistan to care for these refugees.

Thursday 19th March - Syria

Since the start of the civil war in 2011, around 700,000 Christians have left Syria. Pray for an end to this violence and wisdom for world leaders to know how to help. Pray for protection and provision of the Christians remaining in Syria, particularly Muslimbackground believers who are especially vulnerable.

Friday 20th March – Afghanistan

In Afghanistan, those who convert from Islam are considered traitors and excluded by their communities or killed. Pray for the strength and spiritual growth for new believers, particularly those who are isolated. Ask God to protect local believers, expat Christians and foreign aid workers.

Saturday 21st March - Sudan

Many Christians in Sudan are imprisoned or killed for apostasy from the religion of Islam. Pray for Christian girls who are often forced to marry non-Christian men. Praise God that, in spite of persecution, the church in Sudan is growing.

Sunday 22nd March — Iran

In Iran, at least 75 Christians were arrested in 2014 and were physically and mentally abused for their faith. Praise God that many Muslims are choosing to follow Jesus despite the risks. Ask God for protection and wisdom for those reaching out to Muslims with the gospel, in defiance of the laws against this.
