Prayer Diary

MONDAY 11TH MAY: Pray for those who will form the new Government and all who serve in Parliament. Many, sadly, will not consider God as they make decisions and Laws that will affect us all. Pray that there will be amongst them Christians whose faith shines through and whose actions show Godly wisdom and leadership.

TUESDAY 12TH MAY: Tonight Church Committee meets. Pray for each member as they discuss and make decisions on Finance, Property, Media, Arrangements etc. Ask for wisdom to make right choices and encouragements in planning. Give thanks for those who work so hard in the background in many roles.

WEDNESDAY 13TH MAY: We have seen just a fraction of the utter devastation the earthquake brought to Nepal. Pray for all involved in relief efforts. Pray for the Nepalese people, still in deep shock, grief and despair. Ask that the relatively small Christian Church in Nepal will be a Light in their darkness and bring hope to the people who have lost so much when they had so little. Pray that aid money from other nations and charities will be well spent and truly benefit the people most in need.

THURSDAY 14TH MAY: Pray for young people as they face exam time. It is a time of pressure for many of them, so pray that God will give them His peace and may each of them know their worth to Him and how much He cares for them.
