Prayer Diary

Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up. Luke 18:1

Monday, 15th June: Give thanks for all the gifts that we have been able to send to God's work throughout the world through the Mission Fund, Sunday Club, FoG, PW, Midweek, Samaritan's Purse and Life Groups. Ask God to bless our brothers and sisters in Christ as they receive our gifts and realise they are sent with God's love.

Tuesday, 16th June: Pray for our young people as they finish another school year. Pray for God's blessing on all who will serve Him through mission teams. Give thanks that Gillian Stevenson has agreed to lead the Holiday Bible Club and ask God to bless her and the whole team, as they prepare to share God's word with the children.
