### Prayer Diary

**Monday 15th February:** Pray for the PW tonight as they put on a special Valentine's fun night for the church family. Pray that the event is well attended, they raise the necessary funds for their work and that people enjoy the fellowship together.

**Tuesday 16th February:** Pray for families over this half term holiday, that they will enjoy this break and time together. Pray for teachers to have a restful time to recharge their batteries after a busy start to the year.
