Pray for safety and strength for the Christians who remain despite the ever-present danger, in order to minister in the Lord's Name to their countrymen in dire need.

TUESDAY 23rd February: Pray for the 'Time out 4 U' which starts in a week's time. Pray for Essie and all who help with the Mums and the babies and toddlers and ask God to bless their time together with opportunities to get to know each other better, building on the work done each Thursday.
