Prayer Diary



Monday 21st March 2016 'As he approached Jerusalem and saw the city, he wept over it' Luke 19:41

Do we weep for our city, and long for it to find peace? Let us pray not only for the needs that we can see, but for the part of the solution that we can be.

Tuesday 22nd March 2016 'Have faith in God' Mark 11:22

Jesus talked with his disciples about the power of prayer, but also gave them a warning to forgive others so that they may be forgiven. Put your faith in God's power as you pray to him, but also pray for those you need to forgive.

Wednesday 23rd March 2016 'She did what she could' Mark 14:8

While at the home of Simon the Leper, Jesus is anointed by a woman using what she had - a jar of perfume. As you pray today ask for God's help to see what he has given you to enable you to serve him.

Thursday 24th March 2016 'Yet not as I will, but as you will.' Matthew 26:39

In the face of impending suffering Jesus did not serve himself, but instead continued to surrender his authority to his Father. As Christ's followers, do we do the same? Ask that in your life, it would not be your will, but rather God's which is done.

Friday 25th March 2016 'Surely he was the Son of God!' Matthew 27:54

Jesus' death on the cross was the moment that one guard finally came to understand who Jesus is. In your prayers today take time to reflect on the life and death of Jesus, and answer for yourself who Jesus is.

Saturday 26th March 2016 'After three days I will rise again.' Matthew 27:63

The chief priests and Pharisees approached Pilate to put a guard on Jesus' tomb, remembering that he has said he would rise again in three days. While Jesus' disciples hid in fear, his enemies remembered his promises. Pray that God will free you from any fears that cause you to hide, by helping you to remember the promises he has made.

Sunday 27th March 2016 'I have seen the Lord!' John 20:18

The angels declared 'He is not here; he has risen!'. As you pray today celebrate Christ's victory over death and his payment in full for our sins. Christ has bought for us new life, so as we put our faith in him let us declare with confidence that Christ is our Lord!
