Prayer Diary

Monday 30th May

As most of our nation enjoys a bank holiday break from work, remember those for whom work is a place of difficulty and stress. Pray that God will sustain them in their current need, and guide them as to where their future lies.

Tuesday 31st May

Many students are now in the middle of exam season, with all the hopes, fears and expectations that goes with it. Pray for students struggling with exam pressures, and also that there will be someone in their lives to show them that the best thing they can have has no entrance exam.

Wednesday 1st June

As we move into June, the majority of our regular organisational ministries are winding down for their summer break, but the ministry of our church does not take a summer holiday. Pray for the various ministries that run over the summer months.

Thursday 2nd June

There is a huge amount of work in our church that is done by 'unseen helpers', we don't always know who they are and we may not always notice the jobs they have done, but we certainly notice when they aren't there. Give thanks for them.

Friday 3rd June

As the Street Pastors prepare to go out for another weekend, pray for them and the situations they will face. Ask that God might open up good conversations for them and also that they will be kept safe in their work.

Saturday 4th June

Psalm 46 v 10 'Be still, and know that I am God'. Our lives don't tend to lend themselves to being still, but it is something that God tells us to do. Take time today to be still and know in your own life that God is your God.

Sunday 5th June

As we meet together in fellowship today, pray for your fellow believers, perhaps taking some extra time to focus on those sitting in the same row as you. Ask how God can use you to minister to them, and be open to them being used by God to minister to you.
