With Regret

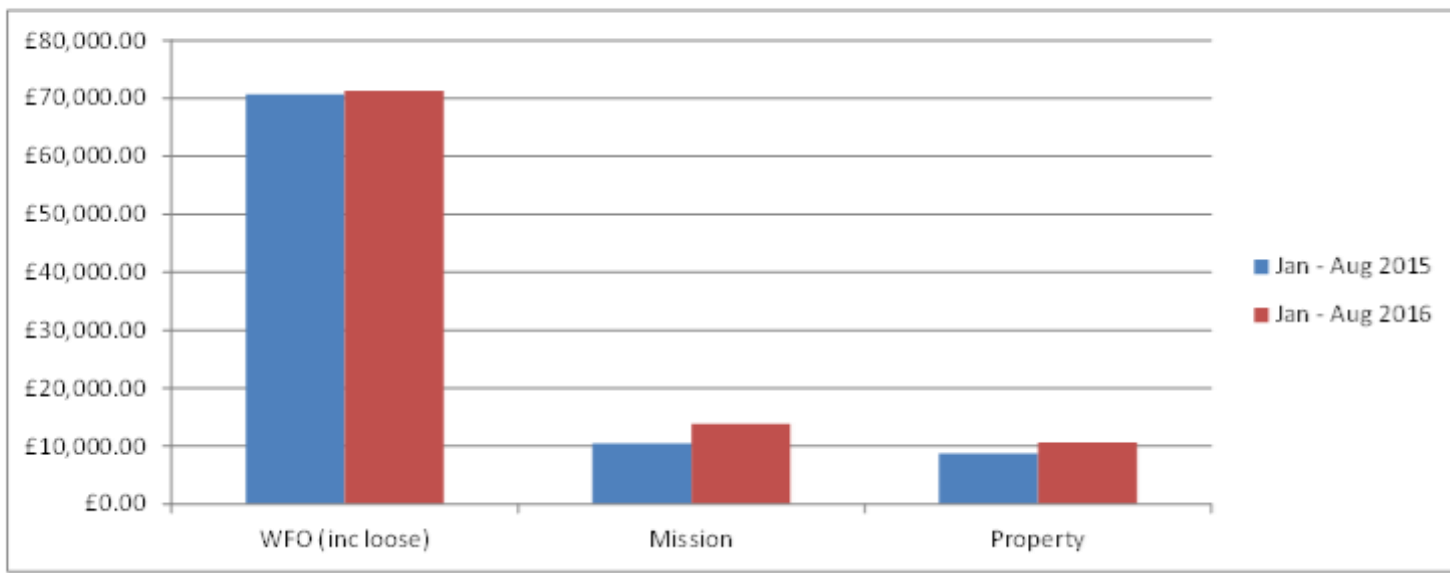
