Prayer Diary

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people.

1 Timothy 2 v 1

 Give thanks for those who lead us. Ask that God would make them wise as they discuss how to reach out to our community with the love of Christ. Ask God to show you how you might explain the hope you have in Christ.

 Pray for those who have been made redundant or are under threat of losing their jobs. Pray that they would know God's guidance as they seek employment.

 Give thanks for the freedom to meet together to worship God. Psalm 95 encourages us to 'sing for joy to the Lord; shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. Come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song.' Pray that as we prepare to come together we would come to worship our God and Saviour.

 Pray for the people of Aleppo, where hundreds of people have been killed following the collapse of the truce deal at the end of September. Ask the Prince of Peace to intervene in His mercy, and raise up peacemakers both inside Syria and in the international community, so that the violence will cease.

 We have agreed to replace the roof on our church building, pray that God would show each one of us how we can contribute to the huge cost involved. Pray that we would make wise decisions about all the resources God has given us.
