#### **Prayer Diary**

Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. 1Tim.1:2

Monday, 28th November: Give thanks for the ministry of David Brice and George Moore, as they lead us in worship and challenge us from God's word. Ask God to guide them in their preparation each week. May we each hear God's voice as we meet together for worship Sunday by Sunday and may our praise be acceptable to God.

Tuesday, 29th November: As we pray for our own church let us remember the Presbyterian Church of South Sudan. Pray that there would be an end to the fighting between the Nuer and Dinka communities who have been fighting each other since 2013.
