Prayer Diary

Monday 24th April: As schools, colleges and universities start back for the last term of the academic year, pray that Christian teachers, students, pupils and support staff would 'Shine from the inside out, so the world can see *He* lives in *them*'.

Tuesday 25th April: As we prepare for another election, ask God to guide us to use our vote for His purposes and not our own. Pray that this would not be a time of division in our community but a time of working together.

Wednesday 26th April: Give thanks for all the plans that have been put in place to replace the church roof. Pray that as contracts are signed and builders move on site, that God would use this time to show us how He wants us to use the resources he has given us to be a witness for him in this place.

Thursday 27th April: – Uzbekistan Pray for ten Uzbek brothers and sisters arrested during a secret prayer meeting. They were questioned for several hours and then released. They have been accused of holding illegal meetings and could face large fines. Pray for their safety and for their future court hearing. **Friday 28th April:** Community and church leaders from Newtownabbey, Ballyclare and Antrim will meet this morning for Breakfast with Les Isaac who is the founder of street pastors. Pray that as Les speaks, God would show this group His vision for our community. **Saturday 29th April:** Tonight Anthony Gibson will be commissioned along with other street pastors from Antrim and Newtownabbey, Ards and Belfast. Pray that God would continue to bless him in this work on the streets of our community.
