Prayer Diary

Monday 1st May: God's word tells us to pray for those in authority and rulers. So we have a duty to do so, even when there is much that frustrates and disappoints. Pray that God's gracious, guiding hand will be on the outcome of our political situation here and in the UK election coming soon.

Tuesday 2nd May: Often, Jesus told those who quoted scripture in their arguments to Him, that they were in error for they did not know the scripture. Pray today that we will all develop a strong faith foundation which will be able to take a stand against those who sow doubt and hostility on Christian belief. Pray too, that God's word will be put into actions by His followers, bringing honour to Him.

Friday 5th May: Pray for those planning new ventures for our Autumn's work. Ask God to guide those looking at youth and children's work and also new plans for Mosaic outreaches. Many hours of work go into preparation for all the events we have here, so ask that each leader will seek to serve God's work here in Glengormley wholeheartedly and draw strength from Him.

Saturday 6th May: Pray for the building work due to begin. Thank God for all those who have contributed finances, time and effort to get us to this stage. Ask God to protect all the workers involved on the project, so that the work is done in safety. Pray for opportunities to be 'salt and light' in the community as people wonder what is going on.
