At a recent meeting of Kirk Session it was agreed to move the evening service of communion in October to the Good Friday Service. That means that the Good Friday Service on 30th March 2018 will be at the usual time of 7:30pm held in the Church as usual but will also be a Communion Service. This completes the transfer of the "double" communion services.

Communion Services are now normally:

- ◆ 1st Sunday morning in January
- ◆ Good Friday
- ◆ 1st Sunday morning in May (or other convenient date)
- ◆ Last Sunday evening in June.
- ◆ 1st Sunday evening in September
- ◆ 1st Sunday morning in October

BEATRICE KIBOLO : You will remember that we asked for prayer for Beatrice as she prepared for the High Court appeal hearing in relation to Visas for her children and son's children at the end of August. Jane (Watters) Gleaves attended court in London with Beatrice and confirmed to the Judge that she and her husband David were prepared to sponsor the application and provide support to the 5 children. Beatrice received a call from her solicitor on Monday night to say that the 5 visas have been granted and the family can be reunited.

This is a wonderful answer to prayer, 10 years since Beatrice fled the Congo. She wishes to thank her church family in Glengormley for all the prayerful and financial support, while she worshiped with us and since she had

to move to the mainland.

Beatrice now has the onerous financial responsibility of getting her family flown over from Kinshasa, the beginning of the end of the family's long ordeal. She would greatly appreciate your continued prayerful support and has faith that God will provide. Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord. Psalm 27: 14
