Prayer Diary

Monday 9th October: Mark 11:24 - Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. As we begin our week, let us be reminded of the power of prayer. Our intercessions are not idle, so let us commit to praying in earnest this week for the people and situations God places on our hearts, as we trust in God's promise to answer our prayers.

Tuesday 10th October: *Isaiah 40:29 - He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.*Prayer highlights our dependence on God; we ask for that which we cannot provide in our own strength. So do not be dismayed by your weakness, but instead let us give thanks for the promised strength that God gives us as we come before Him.

Wednesday 11th October: Exodus 14:14 - The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still. Many of the challenges we face are beyond our ability to affect or change. So as we pray today, let us find peace in knowing that it is not our job to fight, but rather that we are invited to be still, as God fights for us. Be still as you lay your concerns before God.

Thursday 12th October: Jeremiah 29:11 - For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. We may not know the future, but we know the one who does. As we pray today, let us rest in this promise that reminds us that we are here for

God's purposes and He delights to use us to His glory. That we don't know can be ok!

Friday 13th October: John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. Tonight and tomorrow, Street Pastors will be out in Newtownabbey to help make known the greatest promise of all – that God loves us and wants to save us. Pray for the work they do, and for the opportunities they will encounter.

Saturday 14th October: Isaiah 40:31 - But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Take time today to bring before God the things that weary you and weigh you down, give them to Him, and allow Him to renew your strength. The Christian life comes with costs, but our God has promised that we will never be in His debt. He will renew us.

Sunday 15th October: Matthew 11:28 - Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Rest can seem difficult to come by, and for many Sunday can be far from a restful day. But today remember that God has promised to give us rest, and that our rest is important to Him. God set aside a day so that we can rest, so to use it for that purpose is to fulfil the promise it was intended for, both spiritually and physically. Today, find rest with your saviour.
