Our morning service starts at 11am and lasts about one hour. Tea / coffee are served in Mosaic from 10.30am where people chat and mingle both before and after the service.

Our welcome team will be on hand to point you in the right direction or help you find a seat, etc should you need assistance.

We have a great music team at Glengormley and the band usually start the service by leading the first song. The service typically contains a mix of music / singing, Bible readings, prayers, an offering and a short talk / sermon.

## What to expect if you have a disability?

We endeavour to cater for all our members and visitors and offer fully accessible facilities for all users from disability parking spaces and toilet facilities to loop systems and large format print/screen presentations.

We also seek to be autism friendly and our family worker would be happy to discuss your individual needs.

## What to expect if you are accompanied by children?

Children are always made very welcome in our Church family. On a Sunday morning we have events for children aged 0 - 11 years old.

A crèche for babies, toddlers and pre schoolers is provided from 10:45am.

Primary school age children can join our Sunday Club. Typically children will join in with the service for the first 15 minutes during which there is a message especially for them. There will then be an opportunity for children to leave with Sunday Club leaders, or you can accompany them until settled before you return to the church service.

You can also pickup one of our "kid's bags," which are age related bags full of fun things for your child to do if they choose to remain with you throughout the service.

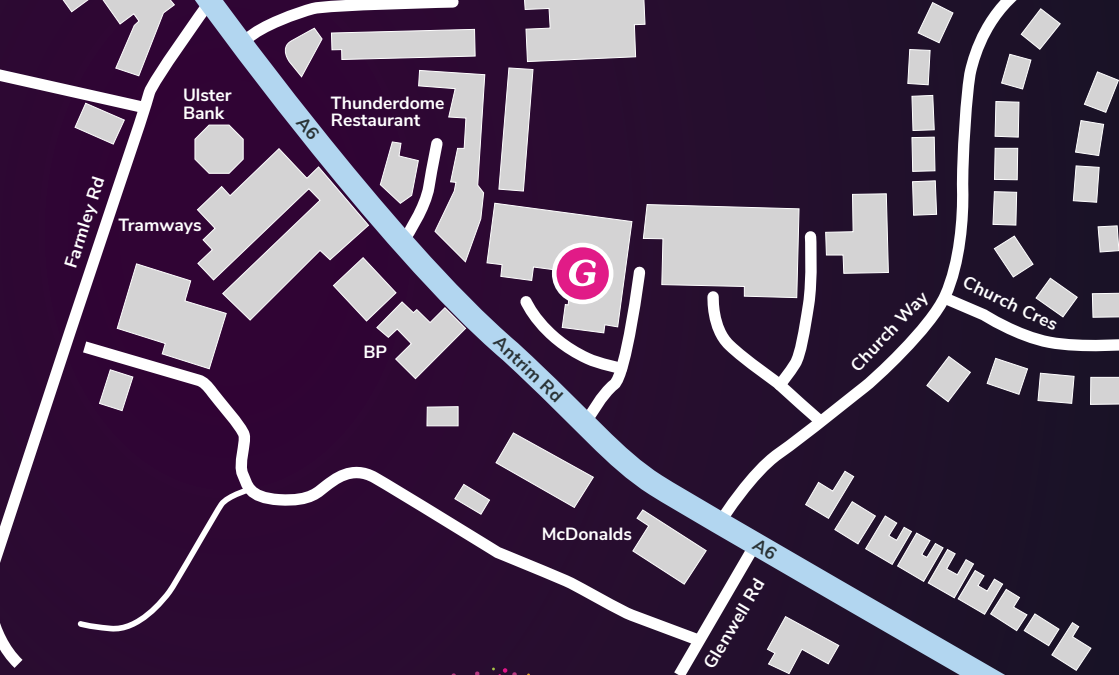
## Life Groups
