Prayer Diary

Monday 21st January 2018: Give thanks for all the outreach activities our church family participate in. May all those involved know Gods leading in this work. Pray also that each of us will play our part in making Glengormley a welcoming church to seekers of all ages.

Tuesday 22nd January 2018: Our Lord Jesus began his earthly life in the poverty of a stable and ended it in the pain and isolation of the cross. So let us pray for all those who are cold and homeless this winter. May our Lord draw near and comfort them in spirit. Also give thanks for those who work to provide them with shelter, food and friendship.

Wednesday 23rd January 2018: For some of our congregation, this New Year will bring trials and tribulations. However our Lord Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever, unchanging in wisdom, power and might. Pray that if it is within His will, we will be protected from danger and delivered from our anxieties.
