**Monday:** Pray for wisdom in resolving the current political situation in Northern Ireland. Pray that Christian leaders and politicians would speak words of knowledge and wisdom to restore Stormont so that decisions can be made to benefit our communities.

**Tuesday:** There has been a clump down in certain provinces in China stopping people sharing the gospel which is making it nearly impossible to talk about their faith without being persecuted. Pray that believers would have courage to share their faith and that they would know Gods protection.

**Wednesday:** Thank you for all those people who serve in youth and church organisations. We thank you for organisations who are involved with unchurched children and young people like Youth for Christ and Crown Jesus ministries.
