Dear Minister

This afternoon I had a conversation with a member of the PSNI Public Protection Team in relation to a report which I had received from one of our ministers.

My attention was drawn to an ongoing alert in relation to the "Momo" cartoon which encourages children to cut themselves and tells them that monsters will jump out of their screens — see attached Facebook alert. Although these concerns have been around for a while, they are again hitting the headlines, together with other images of well-known children's cartoon characters being mutilated.

This is undoubtedly linked to the ongoing trends in self-injury and suicide pacts on social media and are a danger to our children and young people. Please bring this to the attention of parents and leaders, reminding them that it is essential they monitor what children and young people are watching online.
