## Prayer Diary

It is heartbreaking to watch the news of the hundreds of people who have been killed by Cyclone Idai and the half a million left homeless in Mozambique, Malawi and Zimbabwe. Pray for these vulnerable people as they struggle each day to find food and clean water. Ask God to help relief organisations, like Tearfund, as they work to distributed food, cooking utensils and shelter, along with seeds to replant crops destroyed by the winds.

Pray for our Church elders and committee as they start to put the plans in motion for our Church vacancy. Ask that they will feel God's guidance at all times throughout their meetings.

Pray for our children and young people as the exam period approaches. Ask that God will help guide them through their studies and calm their nerves.
