Prayer Diary

As we enter yet another week of turbulent politics it is clear that we are in a hugely important time for our nation. Our prayers are needed. Let us not forget though that God is able to be our refuge and strength even in times like these. So as we pray this week, use the words of Psalm 46 to encourage us.

Monday: This weekend has seen a number of protests against the Westminster proposals that abortion and same sex marriage be introduced here in the event that the NI Assembly is not restored. These are topics that God has much to say on, pray that His words be the clearest and most listened to, both in Westminster and Northern Ireland. May politicians have the courage to act on them.

Tuesday: Northern Ireland continues to suffer due to the lack of the political mechanisms which our country needs to run. Pray that the impasse will be broken and that God will enable our country to move past this point.

Wednesday: Pray too for the NI services which are at breaking point due to the budget limitations the absence of the Assembly creates. Pray that those charged with assigning funding within them will be wise in how they do that, and that they would focus on the needs of those their services are there to support.

Thursday: At the time of writing this it seems likely that we shall soon have another general election. Pray that God will raise up candidates who will be in keeping with His plans and desires for us. Pray too for those politicians who are Christians, that they will have the confidence to follow God's call on their lives, above the demands and influences of party politics and public opinion. Pray too that we will be wise in how we use our vote, that we would vote as God intends.

Friday: Pray for our current politicians. God tells us that they are there by His grace. Regardless of how we view them, may the we honour God through the way we treat them and talk about them. And may we also earnestly pray for their souls - these are people whom God loves.

Saturday: Pray for our denomination as it considers and responds to our ever changing political landscape. May they be wise in their actions and words, and may they boldly shine the light of God's truth onto our nation.

Sunday: Psalm 46:10 - He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." Regardless of what the world does, it cannot diminish God's glory. He is exalted, and will be exalted more, and when all else shall pass, He will remain. Praise Him with confidence today.
