Prayer Diary

International Justice Mission (IJM) are working in Ghana to stop child slavery since 2015. In 2019 they rescued more than 50 children, between the ages of 4 and 17 years old. There are still thousands of children enslaved in forced labour in Lake Volta's fishing industry. Please pray that these children would be set free from slavery and for the ongoing work on IJM.

Tearfund states that more than 911,000 Rohingya people have fled violence in Myanmar and are now living in refugee camps in Bangladesh. Of these, almost 60% are children. Pray that God will be close to them as they mourn, that he will protect them from harm and restore what has been lost. Pray for wisdom for our partners who are in the camps and for long-term, peaceful solutions to the Rohingya crisis.

The coronavirus outbreak is continuing to spread in China and throughout other parts of the World. Please pray that people would be treated and for energy for the health care professionals working in the hospitals.

As Lent approaches on Ash Wednesday, it is supposed to be a challenging time for Christians, as they focus on Jesus' 40 days and 40 nights of temptation in the desert, with many choosing to give something up for 40 days. Thank God that he remains constant with us through all the changing scenes of life. Ask that he will help us to trust him in times of joy and in sorrow. Ask that he will be our shepherd in the darkness and in the light, so that we might be living beacons of hope for others.
