


Sunday 21 March

Moderator | *As the Moderator has recently issued a statement along with the Church Leaders about the marking of the centenary of the formation of Northern Ireland, pray for wise and careful reflection on our past, and the ability to reflect well on matters which might be divisive.*

Friday 26 March



04 LIBYA

There is no freedom of speech or religion. Christians from a Muslim background face violence from their family and community and are vulnerable to attacks by Islamic militant groups

Pray for Libyan Christians under immense pressure to know God's peace.



05 PAKISTAN

Christians face extreme persecution in every area of their lives. Notorious blasphemy laws are used to target Christians, and Christian girls are at risk of abduction and sexual assault.

Pray for Pakistani Christians to have courage to speak about their faith.



06 ERITREA

Christians from non-traditional denominations are persecuted by the government and by the Eritrean Orthodox Church. They can be imprisoned in appallingly inhumane conditions without trial.

Pray for believers in prison, and their families, to know God's provision.



07 YEMEN

Leaving Islam is forbidden and, if discovered, Christians could face the death penalty. Islamic militant groups and tribes may also kill anybody converting to Christianity.

Pray that secret believers will have wisdom and discernment as they support one another.
