Prayer Diary

Sunday 14 November

Pray for all those who have lost loved ones as a result of conflict – that they may experience God's comfort and peace as they mourn their loved ones. Pray for the Moderator as he travels to Thiepval in France with other church leaders for the commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the Ulster Memorial Tower which was built as a tribute to the men of the 9 counties of Ulster who gave their lives in the 1st World War.

Monday 15 November

Pray for Csaba & Ilona Veres (global mission workers, Romania) who have recently returned to Northern Ireland on home assignment. Pray for those in Romania affected by the recent surge in Covid-19 cases. Pray for the teams from the Diakonia who reach out to bring help and support to others.

Tuesday 16 November

Ken Doherty (Chaplain, Mater Hospital, Belfast) | Pray for Ken as he continues his chaplaincy ministry at the Mater and for wisdom and guidance as he ministers to patients, families and staff during difficult times.

Wednesday 17 November

Six people have applied for Ordained Ministry this year. The application process runs through until Easter, with placements, interviews and assignments. Pray that the Lord would guide and give wisdom to applicants and interviewers as together they seek the Lord's will.

Thursday 18 November

Friday 19 November

Saturday 20 November
