## Prayer Diary

### Sunday 13 March

As we worship today ask God to help us to know his forgiving and sustaining grace, pardoning our sins and providing for all our needs.

### Monday 14 March

Pray for an immediate ceasefire and an end to the war in Ukraine. Pray for all directly affected – especially those grieving, the injured and the millions living in constant fear for themselves and / or their loved ones. Pray too for the large Christian community in Ukraine as they continue to worship God and pray for their country.

### Tuesday 15 March

Philip Whelton (Irish Mission Worker in Arklow) | Give thanks that the weekly children and youth clubs are up and running again, and pray that they can continue to build on the relationships already established with the parents and children. Pray for the congregation's plans for events around Easter week.

### Wednesday 16 March

Pray for those who have fled Ukraine or have been displaced within the country. Pray they will find safety and receive the humanitarian and medical assistance they need, both now and in the months ahead. Pray for all trying to get aid to those in need including Christian Aid, Tearfund and Hungarian Reformed Church Aid.

### Thursday 17 March

Pray for Gary Aitcheson's part-time work as a prison chaplain in Magilligan. Pray for guidance as he offers pastoral support and shares the gospel with people in prison.

### Friday 18 March

Consultations on strategies to address domestic abuse and violence against women and girls close next week. Pray for all who are trapped in a cycle of domestic abuse, and pray that they will find the courage to seek help and protection for themselves and their children. Pray that our churches will be a safe place for those who are hurting, and can help provide appropriate support to victims.

### Saturday 19 March
