Prayer Diary

Sunday 15 May: Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker. Psalm 95:6. Ask God to help us to approach him in humility, wonder and awe as we worship today.

Monday 16 May: As the planning for the General Assembly is well underway, pray for Rev Roy Mackay and Rev Mervyn Burnside who convene the groups responsible for the smooth running of the event. Pray too for decision making at the Assembly, that it would reflect the will and mind of Christ.
