Prayer Diary

Pray for The Queen's children, grandchildren and great grandchildren - they will feel the loss of our Queen most keenly. Pray that they will find true peace in Jesus at this time.

Pray for King Charles to seek God's wisdom as he starts his reign.

Pray that the new Prime Minister and her cabinet will govern wisely and use their influence to defend Christian freedom around the world.

Pray for all those who work in our schools as everyone settles into the new school year. Pray especially that Christian teachers, support staff and pupils might have opportunities to share the good news of Jesus Christ amongst their colleagues and peers through their daily interactions. Give thanks for those who volunteer in Scripture Union and other Bible clubs within our schools.

Respite care is an essential element to the overall care of individuals and invaluable support to families and carers. Since the Covid-19 pandemic this service has been reduced and in some instances stopped. Pray for all who provide this valuable service. Pray that families and carers will benefit from their relaxation and breaks.

In NI the number of people diagnosed with dementia is increasing; currently there are approximately 20,000 people diagnosed. In PCI Older People Services care homes we have over 40 beds registered specifically for people with dementia. Pray that people will not feel alone and isolated, and that they will be able to get advice and support from both Health and Social Care services and voluntary services specialising in this area.
