Traditionally at this time of the year we give thanks to God for the harvest. Here at the Foodbank we want to give thanks to Glengormley Presbyterian Church for donating your harvest gifts to the Foodbank.

We have been amazed by the generosity of the donations and these will certainly enable us to help out many families who are finding life a bit of a struggle at the minute. Your contribution weighed in at 112kg which is equivalent to 320 meals. Wow!

In the last quarter (July – September) we supplied food to 1427 people, 595 of whom were children. This is an increase of 30% on 2021 and we fully expect that this trend will continue for some time. So you can see how much we appreciate these donations.

Prayer Diary

Sunday 20 November

You are my strength, I sing praise to you; you, God, are my fortress, my God on whom I can rely. Psalm 59:17. Ask that as we worship today God would empower us with his strength for current challenges we face.

Monday 21 November

Hungarian Reformed Church | Pray for Bishop Sándor Zán-Fábián, the Presiding Bishop of the Reformed Church in Transcarpathia (Ukraine), in his support of local ministers who work with so many displaced by the war.

Tuesday 22 November

Pray for Rev Lesley Ann Wilson (chaplain in Woodlands Juvenile Justice Centre) and the opportunities she has to get to know young people in Woodlands and to pray and share Bible stories with them.

Wednesday 23 November

Joanne Dunlop, deaconess in Craigavon Area and Antrim Area Hospitals - Pray for increased opportunities to build relationships with hospital staff and provide them with support and encouragement. Thursday 24 November
