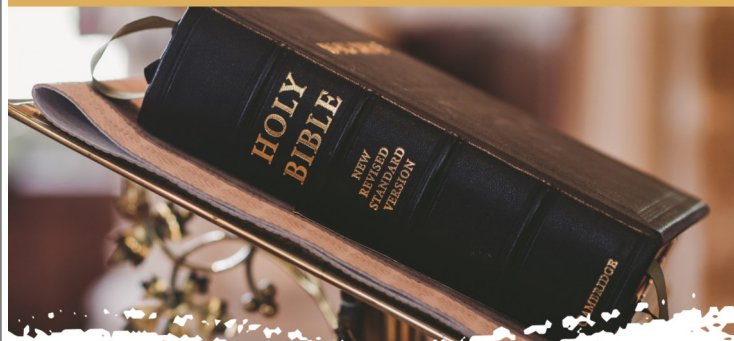

Prayer Diary

Sunday 15 January: *Praise the Lord, all you nations; extol him, all you peoples. 117:1* As we worship today ask God to increase our awareness that we participate in the worship of the worldwide people of God.

Monday 16 January: The Assignments Panel of PCI assigns ministry students to congregations for placements and assistantships – a vital aspect of students' preparation for ministry, providing valuable opportunities to learn alongside a supervising minister. Pray for the Panel as it meets on 27 January, that the Lord would guide its decisions.

Tuesday 17 January: Rev Gary Aitcheson (prison chaplain in HMP Magilligan) Pray for Gary as he seeks to share God's love to the prisoners and staff and that he would find a good balance with his chaplaincy duties amidst his congregational ministry.
