GPC PRAYER: Join us on Sunday mornings between 10:00 and 10:20am (in the Burney Room) and Sunday evenings between 6:30 and 7:30pm (in Mosaic) to pray. Whether you can come along for the whole time or drop in and pray for part of the time, you will be very welcome as we seek God 'for such a time as this'. Sunday: 'Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost'. Isaiah 55:1. Ask God to help us freely find all we need in him as we worship today.
