## Prayer

**GPC PRAYER:** Join us on **Sunday mornings** between **10:00** and **10:20am** (in the Burney Room) . Whether you can come along for the whole time or drop in and pray for part of the time, you will be very welcome as we seek God 'for such a time as this'.

**Sunday:** 'Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest'. Matthew 11:28. Ask God to help us come just as we are to him in worship and find his rest and peace in believing. Pray that as we meet tonight for the new series, 'Practising the Way' that God would use this time to draw us close to him.

**Monday:** Steve and Rosie Kennedy are PCI global mission workers in Romania. Pray for the coordination and administration of ongoing work amongst Ukrainian refugees and for Spirit-led preparations for a range of summer activities.

**Tuesday:** Rev Nigel Craig is PCI chaplain at Queen's University, Stranmillis and Union Theological College. Give thanks for the unity of the new PCI chaplaincy team; and for the many opportunities they have had to serve students and staff at Derryvolgie Hall and on campus this past year. **Wednesday:** Pray for fresh resolve to find a diplomatic solution to the war in Ukraine and remember the ongoing work of Christian Aid, Tearfund, Hungarian Reformed Church Aid and all those caring for refugees and the displaced.

**Thursday:** The cost of living continues to rise. Pray that those on low incomes who are trapped in debt, food and fuel poverty may find the support they need. Pray that we will continue to respond generously to food banks and appeals from charities. Give thanks for Christian organisations who assist those struggling and in need.

**Friday:** Pray for school leaders, teachers, assistants and support staff in Special Schools as they seek to provide opportunities for pupils to flourish and thrive. Pray too for families, many of whom have had compounded challenges arising from budgetary cuts relating to health, education and community services.

**Saturday:** Give thanks for the children and young people connected with our congregation. Pray for leaders in GLOW, Friday Club and Friday Night Thing, that as they build relationships with the young people they would get opportunities to share who Jesus is with them.
