We are also required to train anyone who will be serving food on the premises. Training has been arranged for Monday 13th November at 6:30pm and each organisation is asked to ensure that at least one representative will attend. All attending are asked to sign up on the sheet in Mosaic.

**FOODBANK:** As a church we have generously donated food items to Newtownabbey Foodbank on many



previous occasions. Foodbank volunteers typically support between 30-40 families each week who are experiencing food poverty. Despite the rising food, fuel and energy costs the number of families and individuals receiving help has remained consistent.
